

AOIS on a Mac

In order to run AOIS on a Mac, you'll need to download and install the Remote Desktop Client for Macintosh, then configure an AOIS connection file. To do this, complete the following steps:

1. Point your browser to www.mactopia.com.
2. On the left side of the page, click on Downloads.
3. Near the bottom of the page under Products, click on Remote Desktop.
4. In the Downloads pane, click on Remote Desktop Connection Client 1.0.3 for Mac.
5. In the Details pane, scroll down the page and click on English (.bin).
6. You'll be prompted to either save the file or open it; click on Open.
7. Stuff-It Expander will place a Remote Desktop Connection folder on your desktop; double-click the folder to open it.
8. Double-click on Remote Desktop Connection.
9. In the computer: box, type in the following: ts0002.aoisystem.com
10. Click on Options.
11. In the user name box, type in your AOIS username; leave the other boxes blank.
12. Click on the Display tab; set the display properties to "Full Screen".
13. Click on the Local Resources tab; make sure that "disk drives" and "printers" are selected.
14. Click on the Performance tab; verify that the connection speed is set to 56Kbps (Modem).
15. Click on the General tab; click on "Save As".
16. Type in a name for the connection file and save it to your desktop.
17. Click on Quit.
18. Double-click the connection file that was just saved.
19. Enter your AOIS username (if it's not already there) and password, then click on OK.
