How has AOIS assisted you in your position?

As the Compliance Coordinator for eight academies, working with five different Authorizers in Michigan and Ohio, I have found the FSU format of the AOIS system to be an excellent resource for staying organized, on top of deadlines, and accessing critical data. From the email notifications, to the easily retrieved archival items, to the various calendar-view options and the detailed reporting capabilities, it is obvious that FSUCSO/Corporate Computer has put quite a bit of thought and effort into creating a valuable tool that goes beyond deadlines and document submission.

As an EMO user, what do you like best about AOIS?

One of my favorite features of the FSU AOIS format is the display of the document status directly on the Master Calendar listing on the Home Page. When I sign in, I can quickly see which items need my attention without having to navigate through additional tabs and listings. This is such a time saver!

Some additional favorites are:

- The Master Calendar (MC) Report options also listed on the home page, with the ability to view and print the MC in a monthly calendar format. This allows me to easily keep others in our office in the compliance-loop.
- The Reports and Applications Dashboard! I regularly use this dashboard for its Compliance Reporting options, as well as the Documents Submitted (DST) reports. When needed, these help me track our compliance activity in more detail.
- The 'quick view' of a school's year-to-date compliance statistics on the upper corner of the Compliance Dashboard. This is easy to read and provides details at-a-glance.

What would you tell someone else about AOIS?

All of the above of course, and that the partnership of the FSUCSO and Corporate Computer, Inc. has taken a well put together system from useful to invaluable!
