## AOIS Training Videos and Best Practices Webinar

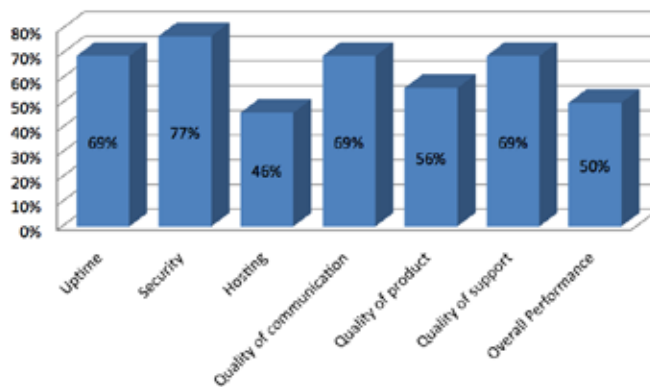
# Corporate Computer Microsoft Client Survey Results

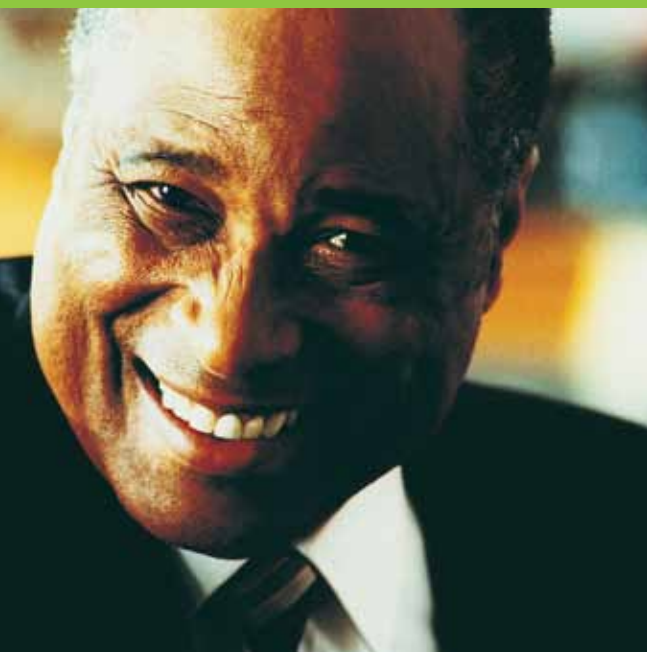
**2010 Microsoft Survey of CC Clients**

## FSU-CSO Spring Briefing Recap

On April 29, the Ferris State University Charter Schools Office (FSU-CSO) held their 8th Annual Spring Briefing in Detroit. The audience included school leaders, assistant school leaders, curriculum directors, assessment coordinators, management company representatives, and the FSU-CSO staff and their field representatives. Many topics were discussed during the meeting and Corporate Computer was asked to present the FSU-CSO Collaborate Portal. Our team at Corporate Computer customized the portal and is assisting in its launch. The FSU-CSO is initially rolling out the Collaborate Portal to their internal Charter School Office staff and plans to extend access to the Portal to school staff and school board members in the near future.
